to use the waters of ONE WELL in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for GROUP DOMESTIC FOR 60 FAMILIES, AND IRRIGATION OF 157.5 ACRES.

This Permit is issued approving Application G-11958. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 11, 1989 FOR DOMESTIC USE AND OCTOBER 12, 1990 FOR IRRIGATION USE. The use is limited to not more than 0.5 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.06 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE AND 0.5 CFS FOR IRRIGATION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 16, T 17 S, R 13 E, W.M.; 710 FEET NORTH AND 1210 FEET WEST FROM E 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 16.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the permit is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4	40.0 ACRES & DOMESTIC
NW 1/4 NE 1/4	37.5 ACRES & DOMESTIC
SW 1/4 NE 1/4	40.0 ACRES & DOMESTIC
SE 1/4 NE 1/4	40.0 ACRES & DOMESTIC

SECTION 16
TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST, W.M.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for a measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. When required by the department, the permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 22, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. By law, the land use associated with this water must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights.
