## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

APACHE WATER COMPANY 22165 BEAR CREEK ROAD BEND, OREGON 97701

to use the waters of THREE WELLS in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for DOMESTIC USE FOR 400 FAMILIES AND TO INCLUDE THE IRRIGATION OF UP TO 1/2 ACRE LAWN OR NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN FOR EACH.

This permit is issued approving Application G-12262. The date of priority is OCTOBER 16, 1990. The use is limited to not more than 500 GALLONS PER MINUTE, BEING 160 GALLONS PER MINUTE EACH FROM WELL 1 & 2 AND 180 GALLONS PER MINUTE FROM WELL 3, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

WELS 1 & 2 - NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 25, WELL 3 - NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 36, T 18 S, R 11, E, W.M.; WELL 1 - 70 FEET SOUTH AND 1800 FEET EAST, WELL 2 - 110 FEET SOUTH AND 1800 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM THE W 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 25, WELL 3 - 1110 FEET SOUTH AND 130 FEET EAST FROM THE N 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 36.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the permit is as follows:

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. When required by the department, the permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 22, 1992, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. Complete application of the water shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.
