to use the waters of TWO WELLS in the TRUAX CREEK BASIN for GROUP DOMESTIC USE FOR TWENTY FIVE FAMILIES INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE FOR EACH.

This permit is issued approving Application G-12256. The date of priority is OCTOBER 9, 1990. The use is limited to not more than 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 35, T 10 S, R 3 W, W.M.: 110 FEET NORTH AND 1040 FEET EAST; 270 FEET SOUTH AND 795 FEET EAST; BOTH FROM NE CORNER, DLC 40.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the permit is as follows:

S 1/2 SE 1/4 SECTION 35 TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

NW 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 2
TOWNSHIP 11 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. When required by the department, the permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 25, 1992, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1993. Complete application of the water shall be made on or before October 1, 1994.
