## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of ONE WELL in the EVANS CREEK BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 26.7 ACRES.

This Permit is issued approving Application G-11979. The date of priority is OCTOBER 27, 1989. The use is limited to not more than 0.167 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 5, T 35 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 26 FEET SOUTH AND 476 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 5.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the permit is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 22.1 ACRES NE 1/4 NW 1/4 4.6 ACRES SECTION 5 TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for a measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. When required by the department, the permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 15, 1992, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1993. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1994.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. By law, the land use associated with this water must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.
