to use the waters of THREE WELLS in the LITTLE PUDDING RIVER BASIN for QUASI-MUNICIPAL USE.

This permit is issued approving Application G-12216. The date of priority is AUGUST 29, 1990. The use is limited to not more than 1.894 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, BEING 1.225 CFS FROM WELL 1, 0.223 CFS FROM WELL 2A AND 0.446 CFS FROM WELL 2B, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 31; SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 30, T 7 S, R 2 W, W.M.; WELL 1 - 1577 FEET SOUTH AND 2244 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, DLC 39; WELL 2A - 189 FEET SOUTH AND 660 FEET EAST; WELL 2B - 184 FEET SOUTH AND 660 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM SW CORNER, JACOB ROBBINS DLC.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the permit is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 SECTION 6 TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M. The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. When required by the department, the permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.
