PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of A WELL in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 40.05 ACRES.

This permit is issued approving Application G-12413. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 15, 1991. The use is limited to not more than 0.50 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 14, T 21 S, R 10 E, W.M.; SOUTH 37 DEGREES 25 MINUTES 37 SECONDS WEST 1719.28 FEET FROM NE CORNER OF SECTION 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, between April 1 and November 1.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this permit is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4	3.69 ACRES
NW 1/4 NE 1/4	12.09 ACRES
SW 1/4 NE 1/4	18.26 ACRES
SE 1/4 NE 1/4	6.01 ACRES

SECTION 14

TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

Before use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the measuring device, shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or as may be required by the Director.

A regulating device shall be installed pursuant to ORS 540-310.

Use of water under this permit is subject to all prior rights.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 24, 1994, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1995. Complete application of the water shall be made on or before October 1, 1996.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.
