## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

FRANK AND BARBARA MICHAELIS 65480 73RD STREET BEND, OREGON 97701

to use the waters of A WELL in the CROOKED RIVER BASIN for DOMESTIC USE for 60 families including the IRRIGATION of not to exceed 1/2 acre of lawn and non-commercial garden for each.

This permit is issued approving Application G-13213. The date of priority is DECEMBER 11, 1992. The use is limited to not more than 50.0 GALLONS PER MINUTE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 16, T 14 S, R 13 E, W.M.; 2802.75 feet North and 1584.89 feet East from the Southwest corner of section 16.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this permit is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic - 60 families SECTION 16
TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST, W.M.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The Director may at any time require the permittee to report general water use information, including the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit.
- B. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order
- C. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- D. The Director may at any time require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

If substantial interference with a senior water right occurs due to withdrawal of water from any well listed on this permit, then use of water from the well(s) shall be discontinued or reduced and/or the schedule of withdrawal shall be regulated until or unless the Department approves or implements an alternative administrative action to mitigate the interference. The Department encourages junior and senior appropriators to jointly develop plans to mitigate interferences.

Groundwater production shall be from no shallower than 250 feet below land surface.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 30, 1994 and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1995. Complete application of the water shall be made on or before October 1, 1996.

This permit is for beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

The Commission finds that the proposed use(s) of water described by this permit, as conditioned, would not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.
