to use the waters of 10 WELLS in the INGRAM SLOUGH BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 295.2 ACRES.

This permit is issued approving Application G-12535. The date of priority is MAY 14, 1991. The use is limited to not more than 3.69 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.24 CFS FROM WELL 1; 0.57 CFS FROM WELL 2; 0.29 CFS FROM WELL 3; 0.20 CFS FROM WELL 4; 0.27 CFS FROM WELL 5; 0.48 CFS FROM WELL 6; 0.15 CFS FROM WELL 7; 0.68 CFS FROM WELL 8; 0.42 CFS FROM WELL 9; AND 0.37 CFS FROM WELL 11; or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

- WELL 1 - SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 30, T 15 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 700 FEET NORTH AND 580 FEET EAST OF THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30.
- WELL 2 - SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 30, T 15 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 680 FEET NORTH AND 1080 FEET EAST OF THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30.
- WELL 3 - NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 30, T 15, S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1340 FEET NORTH AND 890 FEET EAST OF THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30.
- WELL 4 - NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 30, T 15 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1340 FEET NORTH AND 1540 FEET EAST OF THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30.
- WELL 5 - NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 30, T 15 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1950 FEET NORTH AND 900 FEET EAST OF THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30.
- WELL 6 - SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 30, T 15 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1700 FEET SOUTH AND 1340 FEET EAST OF THE SW CORNER OF DLC #57.
- WELL 7 - SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 30, T 15 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1420 FEET SOUTH AND 620 FEET EAST OF THE SW CORNER OF DLC #57.
- WELL 8 - SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 30, T 15 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1340 FEET SOUTH AND 690 FEET EAST OF THE SW CORNER OF DLC #57.
- WELL 9 - NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 30, T 15 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 150 FEET SOUTH AND 10 FEET EAST OF THE SW CORNER OF DLC #57.
- WELL 11 - SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 30, T 15 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1470 FEET SOUTH AND 580 FEET WEST OF THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The period of allowed use is March 1 through October 31.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this permit is as follows:

SECTION 30

TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order, shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.
- B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice. Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

In the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation or alteration of the appropriation facility associated with this authorized diversion, the quantity of water allowed herein, together with any other right, shall not exceed the capacity of the facility at the time of perfection of this right.

Actual construction of the well shall begin on or before September 29, 1996 and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1997. Complete application of water shall be made on or before October 1, 1998.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.


This permit is for beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

The Director of the Water Resources Department has found that the proposed use of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.
