The specific limits for the use are listed below along with conditions of use.

APPLICATION FILE NUMBER: G-13288

SOURCE OF WATER: A Well within the Elk River Basin

PURPOSE OR USE: Fish Life Use

MAXIMUM FLOW/VOLUME ALLOWED: 0.63 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

PERIOD OF USE: Year round.

DATE OF PRIORITY: February 8, 1993

POINT OF DIVERSION LOCATION: SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 6, R 33 S, R 14 W,
W. M.; 110 FEET NORTH, 1070 FEET EAST THE S 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6.

THE PLACE OF USE IS LOCATED AS FOLLOWS:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 6, T 33 S, R 14 W

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install two metering or other suitable measuring devices as approved by the Director. One device will measure the amount of water pumped into the system for fish incubation purposes and the second device will measure the amount of water pumped from the system into the Elk River. The permittee shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order, shall keep a complete record of the amount of water pumped into and out of the system each month. The permittee shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.

- B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

STANDARD CONDITIONS

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The Director finds that the proposed use of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

Actual construction of the well shall begin on or before October 17, 1996, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1997. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1998.

This permit is issued to correctly describe the dates for beginning and completion of construction, and complete application of the water to the use allowed herein. Permit G-12180 is superseded by this instrument and is of no further force or effect.
