The specific limits and conditions for the use are listed below.

APPLICATION FILE NUMBER: G-12637

SOURCE OF WATER: ONE WELL WITHIN THE GOOSE & SUMMER LAKES BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 1506.23 ACRES, LIMITED TO A MAXIMUM OF 450 ACRES EACH IRRIGATION SEASON

MAXIMUM RATE: 2.12 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND

PERIOD OF USE AND VOLUME LIMITATIONS: MARCH 1 THROUGH APRIL 15 TO A MAXIMUM VOLUME OF 189 ACRE FEET AND JULY 1 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 1 TO A MAXIMUM VOLUME OF 252 ACRE FEET. THE USE OF WATER WILL BE RESTRICTED WHEN HART LAKE DROPS BELOW ELEVATION 4467 FEET (8 FEET BELOW THE SPILLWAY)

DATE OF PRIORITY: AUGUST 16, 1991

POINT OF DIVERSION LOCATION: SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 18, T36S, R25E, W.M.; 521 FEET NORTH AND 4361 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER SECTION 18

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order, shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.
- B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

In the interest of conserving surface water, this permit may be exercised to satisfy the primary right provided that it does not exceed the limitations provided herein.

If substantial interference with a senior water right occurs due to withdrawal of water from any well listed on this permit, then use of water from the well(s) shall be discontinued or reduced and/or the schedule of withdrawal shall be regulated until or unless the Department approves or implements an alternative administrative action to mitigate the interference. The Department encourages junior and senior appropriators to jointly develop plans to mitigate interferences.

STANDARD CONDITIONS

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

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Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

The Director finds that the proposed use(s) of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

Actual construction of the well shall begin within one year from permit issuance, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1999. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 2000.
