SOURCE OF WATER: WELLS 1,3,4 & 5 IN THE SANTIAM RIVER BASIN USING WATER FROM THE WILLAMETTE BASIN PROJECT RESERVOIRS, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-1625 WITHIN THE WILLAMETTE BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 125.4 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 1.57 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND NOT TO EXCEED 200.0 ACRE-Feet PER YEAR, OR AS FURTHER LIMITED BY THE WATER SERVICE CONTRACT

PERIOD OF USE: MARCH 1 THROUGH OCTOBER 31

DATE OF PRIORITY: JANUARY 15, 1991

POINT OF DIVERSION LOCATION: WELL #1-SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 29, T9S, R3W, W.M.; SOUTH 69 DEGREES 45 MINUTES WEST 56.5 CHAINS FROM NW CORNER, DLC 56 WELL #3-SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 32, T9S, R3W, W.M.; SOUTH 39 DEGREES 00 MINUTES WEST 74 CHAINS FROM NW CORNER, DLC 56 WELL #4-SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 32, T9S, R3W, W.M.; SOUTH 27 DEGREES 00 MINUTES WEST 73.5 CHAINS FROM NW CORNER, DLC 56 WELL #5-NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 31, T9S, R3W, W.M.; 150 FEET SOUTH & 480 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 31

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

## SECTION 32

TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

## Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order, shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.
- B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

In the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation or alteration of the appropriation facility associated with this authorized diversion, the quantity of water allowed herein, together with any other right, shall not exceed the capacity of the facility at the time of perfection of this right.

If substantial interference with a senior water right occurs due to withdrawal of water from any well listed on this permit, then use of water from the well(s) shall be discontinued or reduced and/or the schedule of withdrawal shall be regulated until or unless the Department approves or implements an alternative administrative action to mitigate the interference. The Department encourages junior and senior appropriators to jointly develop plans to mitigate interferences.

The use of water under this right is subject to the terms and conditions of contract No. 7-07-10-W1163, or a satisfactory replacement, between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

## STANDARD CONDITIONS

The wells shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.


By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

The Director finds that the proposed use(s) of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

Actual construction of the well shall begin within one year from permit issuance. Complete application of water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 2001.
