PURPOSE OR USE: WELL #1 - DOMESTIC USE FOR 100 HOUSEHOLDS AND 16 CAMP FACILITY BUILDINGS, AND HUMAN CONSUMPTION FOR 246 RV SITES; WELLS #2 AND #3 - QUASI-MUNICIPAL USE

RATE OF USE: 0.165 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.078 CFS FROM WELL #1, 0.031 CFS FROM WELL #2, AND 0.056 CFS FROM WELL #3

PERIOD OF ALLOWED USE: YEAR ROUND

DATE OF PRIORITY: APRIL 9, 1992

POINT OF DIVERSION LOCATION: LOTS 31 & 32, SECTION 12; LOT 2, SECTION 13, T5S, R11W, W.M.; WELL #1- 410 FEET SOUTH AND 1020 FEET WEST FROM THE NW CORNER SECTION 13; WELL #2- 610 FEET SOUTH AND 710 FEET EAST, WELL #3- 250 FEET SOUTH & 435 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM THE SE 1/16<sup>TH</sup> SECTION 12

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
- B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- C. The Director requires the permittee to keep, maintain and submit records of the amount (volume) of water used from Well #1. The permittee is required to report water use from Well #1 annually. In addition, the Director may require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used on Wells #2 & #3, listed on this permit and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. The permittee may also be required to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water from all wells listed under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

If substantial interference with a senior water right occurs due to withdrawal of water from any well listed on this permit, then use of water from the well(s) shall be discontinued or reduced and/or the schedule of withdrawal shall be regulated until or unless the Department approves or implements an alternative administrative action to mitigate the interference. The Department encourages junior and senior appropriators to jointly develop plans to mitigate interferences.

**STANDARD CONDITIONS**

The wells shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.


The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

The Director finds that the proposed use(s) of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

**This permit is issued to correctly describe the required dates of completion. Permit G-13643, dated April 21, 1999, is superseded by this instrument and is of no further force or effect.**

Actual construction of the well shall begin within one year from permit issuance, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 2000. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 2003.
