The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

APPLICATION FILE NUMBER: G-15014

SOURCE OF WATER: A WELL IN BIRCH CREEK BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 2.08 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.026 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

PERIOD OF USE: MARCH 1 THROUGH OCTOBER 31

DATE OF PRIORITY: AUGUST 13, 1999

POINT OF DIVERSION LOCATION: SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 14, T1N, R32E, W.M.;
1124 FEET NORTH & 50 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 14

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre feet per acre per year during the irrigation season of each year.

THE PLACE OF USE IS LOCATED AS FOLLOWS:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 2.08 ACRES
SECTION 14
TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 32 EAST, W.M.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The Director may require the permittee to install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. If the Director notifies the permittee to install a meter or other measuring device, the permittee shall install such

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in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

The Director finds that the proposed use(s) of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

Actual construction of the well shall begin by August 18, 2001. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 2004. Within one year after complete application of water to the proposed use, the permittee shall submit a claim of beneficial use, which includes a map and report, prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner (CWRE).
