SOURCE OF WATER: A WELL IN WILLOW CREEK BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 6.3 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 129.9 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 1.70 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.08 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 1.62 CFS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION

PERIOD OF USE: MARCH 1 THROUGH OCTOBER 31

DATE OF PRIORITY: DECEMBER 30, 1999

POINT OF DIVERSION LOCATION: SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 9, T1S, R39E, W.M.; 20 FEET NORTH AND 1320 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 9

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.


By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

The Director finds that the proposed use(s) of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 2004. Within one year after complete application of water to the proposed use, the permittee shall submit a claim of beneficial use, which includes a map and report, prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner (CWRE).

NOTE: Pursuant to ORS 537.330, in any transaction for the conveyance of real estate that includes any portion of the lands described in this permit, the seller of the real estate shall, upon accepting an offer to purchase that real estate, also inform the purchaser in writing whether any permit, transfer approval order, or certificate evidencing the water right is available and that the seller will deliver any permit, transfer approval order or certificate to the purchaser at closing, if the permit, transfer approval order or certificate is available.
