Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters

This superseding permit is issued to describe an amendment for an additional point of appropriation proposed under Permit Amendment Application T-11359 and approved by Special Order Vol. 87, Page 311 XXX, entered April 17, 2012, and to describe an extension of time for complete application of water approved September 1, 2006 and a Water Management and Conservation Plan approved September 24, 2010 This permit supersedes Permit G-10569.

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11368, and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to City of Wallowa, P.O. Box 487, Wallowa, OR 97885

for the PURPOSE of municipal

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 12, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 4.0 cubic feet per second

measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The combined quantity of water diverted at Well 2, together with that diverted at Well 1, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation, Well 1.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation, Well 1.

The City of Wallowa shall submit an updated Water Management and Conservation Plan no later than **September 24, 2020**, and shall submit a progress report containing the information required under OAR 690-086-0120(4) by **September 24, 2015**.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 17, 1987 and shall

thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 2033.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 2033.
