Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters

This superseding permit is issued to describe an amendment for additional points of appropriation and a change in place of use proposed under Permit Amendment Application T-11352 and approved by Special Order Vol. 20, Page 601, entered 601, 2012, and to describe extensions of time for complete application of water approved July 7, 2009 and October 7, 2011, and assignments to new permittees approved January 24, 1990 and September 15, 2009. This permit supersedes Permit G-10605

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11517, and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to J. Frank Schmidt & Son Company, P.O. Box 189, Boring, Oregon 97009 and Northwest Farm Credit Services, FCLA and PCA, P.O. 13309, Salem, Oregon 97309, for use of waters from six wells.

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 132.3 acres.

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 6, 1986

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.65 cubic feet per second

measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The combined quantity of water diverted at Wells BF-1, BF-3, BF-4, BF-5, and BF-6, together with that diverted at Well BF-2, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation, Well BF-2.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation, Well BF-2.

The last extension of time for Permit G-16943 was approved on October 7, 2011. Any future extensions of time will be denied.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 3, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 2013.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 2013.
