

Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This superseding permit is issued to describe an amendment for additional points of appropriation proposed under Permit Amendment Application T-11324 and approved by Special Order Vol. 86, Page 541, entered SEPTEMBER 17, 2012, and to describe an extension of time for complete application of water approved March 25, 2011. This permit supersedes Permit G-9284.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 165 gallons per minute measured at the point of diversion from the well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from fourteen wells.....

The use to which water is to be applied is quasi-municipal.....

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall further be limited to a diversion of not to exceed acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Permit Amendment T-11324 Conditions

The combined quantity of water diverted at the new additional points of appropriation, China Hat No. 1 Well, China Hat No. 2 Well, Deschutes River Woods Well, Parrell Road Well, Riverbend No. 1 Well, Riverbend No. 2 Well, Riverbend No. 3 Well, Sundance Well No. 2, Tekampe Well No. 1, Tekampe Well No. 2, Tekampe Well No. 3, Dyer No. 1 Well, and Gosney Well, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of appropriation, Conestoga Well.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

The priority date of this permit is March 11, 1981.....

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 18, 1982..... and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 2014.....

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 2014.....
