PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

This superseding permit is issued to describe an amendment for a change in point of appropriation proposed under Permit Amendment Application T-12506 and approved by Special Order Vol. 104, Page 663, entered APR 27 2017, and to describe an extension of time for complete application of water approved May 20, 2014 and an assignment to a new permittee approved January 6, 2014. This permit supersedes Permit G-11362.

To use the waters of ONE WELL in the WILLAMETTE RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION of 143.4 ACRES.

This Permit is issued approving Application G-11933. The date of priority is June 13, 1989. The use is limited to not more than 0.12 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for a measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. When required by the department, the permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The water user shall report March water levels in the well to the Groundwater/Hydrology Section of the Water Resources Department by April 15 of each year. The measurement shall be made and calculations detailed by a certified water rights examiner, registered professional geologist, certified engineering geologist, or professional engineer. Use of water from the well shall not be allowed under this permit if the well displays loss of hydraulic head equal to a water level decline of 25 or more feet.

The Water Resources Department has determined that the initial water level in the well was equivalent to 20 feet above land surface on April 21, 1988. That is the level from which previously cited declines will be referenced.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.


This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 3, 1992, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1993. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1994. By Extension of Time Final Order dated July 25, 2014 the completion of the application of water was extended to on or before October 1, 2022.
