This superseding permit is issued to describe an amendment for a change in place of use and an additional point of appropriation proposed under Permit Amendment Application T-12894 and approved by Special Order Vol. 116, Page 14, entered MAR 1 1 2020, and to describe extensions of time for complete application of water approved September 22, 1980, February 20, 1985, February 16, 1990, February 2, 1995, June 13, 2005, and August 29, 2014. This permit supersedes Permit G-7029

### Permit Amendment T-12894 Conditions:

The combined quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

# Extension of Time Conditions:

## **Development Limitation:**

The limitation of the diversion of water under Permit G-7029 established by the extension of time approved on August 29, 2014 is removed, and, subject to other limitations or conditions of the permit, the City of Fairview is now authorized to divert up to 1.1 cfs (out of the total permitted 2.2 cfs) under Permit G-7029.

Failure to meet the conservation benchmarks listed below may result in the reduction of the quantity of water authorized for diversion under Permit G-7029 during review of the City's next plan update.

- a. Annual water audit (Finding of Fact 8(a))
- b. Leak detection (Finding of Fact 8(c))

## Original Permit Conditions:

The well shall be cased as necessary in accordance with good practice and if the flow is artesian the works shall include proper capping and control valve to prevent the waste of groundwater.

The works constructed shall include an airline and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device and shall keep a complete record of the amount of groundwater withdrawn.

Actual construction of the well was to begin within one year from permit issuance (October 27, 1976) and was to be complete on or before October 1, 1978. Complete application of the water to the use was to be made on or before October 1, 1979. By Extension of Time Final Order dated August 29, 2014, the completion of construction and application of water was extended to on or before October 1, 2040.
