APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Ground Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Charles F. Thomas (Name of applicant) of River Rd., Gladstone (Postoffice Address), county of Clackamas state of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described ground waters of the state of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. Give name of nearest stream to which the well, tunnel or other source of water development is situated Clackamas river (Name of stream)

tributary of Willamette River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 200 cubic feet per second or 200 gallons per minute.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Watering of golf course

4. The well or other source is located ft. and 1149 ft. E/4 from the center of River Rd. which is 106 feet north of a stone 35.37 chains S. 78° W 7.88 chains W. of the quarter section corner between Sections 19 and 20 (Section or subdivision)

2863.0 ft South & 1479 ft West from E 1/4 cor Sec 19 (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the N 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 30, Twp. 2. S., R. 2. E. of W. M., in the county of Clackamas

6. The name of the well or other works is A well

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

7. If the flow to be utilized is artesian, the works to be used for the control and conservation of the supply when not in use must be described.

8. The development will consist of one well (Give number of wells, tunnels, etc.) having a diameter of ten inches and an estimated depth of 60 to 65 feet. It is estimated that 56 feet of the well will require steel (Kind) casing. Depth to water table is estimated 34 feet (Feet)

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a well

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be cased as necessary in accordance with good practice and if the flow is artesian the works shall include proper capping and control valve to prevent the waste of ground water.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The priority date of this permit is May 16, 1961

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 11, 1962 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1962

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1963
