APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Ground Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Mrs. George Rowden (Name of applicant)

of Pitt Star Route, Box 88, Butte Falls, county of Jackson (Postoffice Address)

state of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described ground waters of the state of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. Give name of nearest stream to which the well, tunnel or other source of water development is situated Ash Creek, tributary of S. Fk. Big Butte Creek, tributary of Big Butte Creek tributary of Rogue River (Name of stream)

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.04 cubic feet per second or gallons per minute.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation.

4. The well or other source is located 615 ft. N. and 35 ft. E. from the S1/4 corner of Section 20 (N. or S.) (E. or W.) (Section or subdivision)

(If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

(If there is more than one well, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary)

being within the SW1/4 SE1/4 of Sec. 20, Twp. 35 S., R. 3 E., W. M., in the county of Jackson.

5. The pipeline to be 400 feet in length, terminating in the SE1/4 SW1/4 of Sec. 20, Twp. 35 S., R. 3 E., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Canal or pipe line) (Smallest legal subdivision)

6. The name of the well or other works is Rowden Sump

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

8. The development will consist of one sump having a diameter of inches and an estimated depth of 6 feet. It is estimated that feet of the well will require no casing. Depth to water table is estimated 1 foot. Sump 10' x 10' x 6' depth. (Kind) (Feet)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a sump

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be cased as necessary in accordance with good practice and if the flow is artesian the works shall include proper capping and control valve to prevent the waste of ground water.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The priority date of this permit is December 8, 1965

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 19, 1967 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1967

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1968
