APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To Appropriate the Ground Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Dennis F. Sigmon

state of Oregon 97501, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described ground waters of the state of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.05 cubic feet per second or _____ gallons per minute.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation.

4. The well or other source is located 530 ft. N. and 200 ft. W. from the SE corner of Section 35
(N. or S.) (E. or W.) (Section or subdivision)

being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 35, Twp. 37 S., R. 4 W., W. M., in the county of Jackson.

5. The pipeline (Canal or pipe line) to be 600 feet _____ miles in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 (Smallest legal subdivision) of Sec. 35, Twp. 37 S., R. 4 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the well or other works is Sigmon Well.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

7. If the flow to be utilized is artesian, the works to be used for the control and conservation of the supply when not in use must be described.

8. The development will consist of one well (Give number of wells, tunnels, etc.) having a diameter of 6 inches and an estimated depth of 94 feet. It is estimated that 51 feet of the well will require 0.250 steel (Kind) casing. Depth to water table is estimated 33 feet. (Feet)

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Sigmon Well

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be cased as necessary in accordance with good practice and if the flow is artesian the works shall include proper capping and control valve to prevent the waste of ground water.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The priority date of this permit is May 15, 1975

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 24, 1977 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1977

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1978
