make application for a permit to appropriate the following described ground waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The development will consist of one (Give number of wells, tile lines, infiltration galleries, etc.)

having a diameter of 12" and an estimated depth of 210 feet.

2. The well or other source is to be located 1383 ft. N. and 1278 ft. E. (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

from the S.W. corner of Sec. 8 T. 26 S. R. 18 E. W.M. (Public Land Survey Corner)

(If there is more than one well, each must be described)

being within the N.W. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 8 Tp. 26 S. R. 18 E., W.M., in the county of Lake

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if use other than irrigation.

Table with 5 columns: Township, Range, Section, List 1/4 1/4 of Section, List use and/or number of acres to be irrigated. Rows include T26S 18E 8 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 40, T26S 18E 8 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 40, etc.

4. It is estimated that 60 feet of the well will require metal casing. (Kind)

5. Depth to water table is estimated Well drilled by Claude Blackmen. (Feet)

6. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is cubic feet per second or 9000 gallons per minute.

7. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigating Barley & Alfalfa

8. If the flow to be utilized is artesian, the works to be used for the control and conservation of the supply when not in use must be described.

9. If the location of the well, or other development work is less than one-fourth mile from a natural stream channel, give the distance to the channel and the difference in elevation between the stream bed and the ground surface at the source of development.

12. Construction work will be completed on or before May 30 1981

13. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before May 30 1981

14. If the ground water supply is supplemental to an existing supply, identify the supply and existing water right.

Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a well.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that in the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation or repair of this well, the quantity of water allowed herein, together with any other right from this point of appropriation shall not exceed the capacity of this well at the time of perfection of this right.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The priority date of this permit is February 23, 1981

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 15, 1982 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983
