DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

Existing System: Built in 1978 consists of a 408' deep 6" diameter well equipped with a 15 HP submersible pump; controls: a 100,000 rectangular, cast in place concrete, ground level storage reservoir and some 8500 feet of 2", 4", 6", 8", 10", 12" and 14" pipe and some 32 services.

Proposed System Improvements 1981 & 82: Distribution System Extension of 13000 feet of 4", 6" & 10" Pipe a 2nd well and some 87 additional services.

11. Construction work will begin on or before May 15, 1982

12. Construction work will be completed on or before May 15, 1983

13. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before May 15, 1985

14. If the ground water supply is supplemental to an existing supply, identify the supply and existing water right.

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 55 gallons per minute, ~~or more~~ measured at the point of diversion from the well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a well

The use to which this water is to be applied is quasi-municipal

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed ----- acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The priority date of this permit is May 6, 1981

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 27, 1982 and shall

thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982
