PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined Application G-9504 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Tad L. Milburn, City Administrator, City of Sherwood, Oregon of City Hall, 90 Northwest Park Street, Sherwood, Oregon 97140, Phone 625-5522, for the use of the waters of two wells, being 0.4 cubic foot per second from Well 2 and 0.87 cfs from Well 3, for the purpose of municipal use; that the priority of the right dates from November 3, 1980 and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.27 cubic feet per second measured at the points of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The wells are to be located: $\frac{\text{Well 2}}{3}$ - 1,680 feet south and 1,610 feet east from the northwest corner of Section 32; and $\frac{\text{Well 3}}{3}$ - 750 feet north and 600 feet west from the northwest center of Section 32, both wells being within the SE I/4NW I/4, Township 2 South, Range I West, WM, in the county of Washington.

A description of the place of use under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows

The wells shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in each well at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 8, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1,
