PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined Application G-9615 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Yolanda Renner of 1215 South Columbus Avenue, Medford, Oregon 97501, Phone 772-2117, for the use of the waters of one sump, for the purpose of irrigation and supplemental irrigation; that the priority of the right dates from March 14, 1980 and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.23 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the sump, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The sump is to be located: 750 feet south and 160 feet west from the center of Section 35, being within the NE 1/45W 1/4, Township 37 South, Range 2 West, WM, in the county of Jackson.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed two and one-half acre-teet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 37 South Range 2 West, WM Section 35 SE 1/4NW 1/4 9.5 acres primary
NE 1/4SW 1/4 6.0 acres primary
NE 1/4SW 1/4 2.5 acres supplemental

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 8, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
