PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined Application G-10281 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Fir View Water Company of 6025 Northwest Primrose, Albany, Oregon 97321, Phone 926-4544, for the use of the waters of three wells, being 0.13 cubic foot per second from Well 6, 0.10 cfs from Well 4, and 0.01 cfs from Well 1, for the purpose of group domestic use for 79 families including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden; that the priority of the right dates from April 21, 1981 for 0.13 cfs from Well 6, and July 21, 1981 for 0.11 cfs from Wells 1 and 4 and are limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.24 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The wells are to be located: Well 1 - 310 feet south and 525 feet west; Well 4 - 240 feet south and 535 feet west, both from the center of the NW 1/4 of Section 23, being within the SW 1/4NW 1/4; Well 6 - 250 feet north and 722 feet east from the northwest corner of Section 23, being within the SW 1/4SW 1/4 of Section 14, all from Township 10 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the county of Benton.

A description of the place of use under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The wells shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in each well at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 8, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
