PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-9874 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Liskey Farms, Inc. of PO Box 467, Merrill, Oregon 97633, phone 798-5770, for the use of the waters of three wells, being 2.2 cubic feet of water per second from Well 1 and 2.7 cfs from Well 3 with backup supply from Well 2, for the PURPOSE of space heating and other uses in greenhouses, and temperature control and water level control in ponds for fish culture; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 17, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 4.9 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The wells are to be LOCATED: Well 1 - North 12 degrees 07 minutes 40 seconds East, 3,862.2 feet from the S 1/4 Corner of Section 34, being within Lot 1, Section 34, Township 40 South, Range 9 East, WM; Well 2 - North 19 degrees 57 minutes 50 seconds East, 3,842.6 feet from the S 1/4 Corner of Section 34, being within Lot 2, Township 40 South, Range 9 East, WM; Well 3 - North 26 degrees 07 minutes 15 seconds East, 3,931.6 feet from the S 1/4 Corner of Section 34, being within Lot 2, Township 40 South, Range 9 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 40 South	Range 9 East, WM	Section 34	Lots 1, 2 and 4	Space heating and greenhouse use
			Lots 1 and 4	Fish culture

The wells shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 30, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983. Extended to Oct. 1985

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984. Extended to Oct. 1, 1986
