PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10341 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Raymond and Margaret Prag of 990 Tetherow Road, Williams, Oregon 97544, phone 846-6963, for the use of the waters of four wells, being 0.002 cubic foot per second of water from Well 1, 0.087 cfs from Well 2, 0.044 cfs from Well 3, and 0.107 cfs from Well 4, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 26, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.24 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The wells are to be LOCATED: Well 1 - 1,210 feet South and 940 feet East; Well 2 - 200 feet South and 440 feet East; Well 3 - 785 feet South and 725 feet East; Well 4 - 1,000 feet South and 1,160 feet East, all being from the Corner common to Sections 27, 28, 33, and 34, and all being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 34, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 38 South Range 5 West, WM Section 34 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 19.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The wells shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the wells at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 19, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
