PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10460 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Michael B. Oonivan of Route 5, Box 106-A, The Dalles, Oregon 97058, phone 298-5643, for the use of the waters of Wells I and 2, for the PURPOSE of irrigation from Well I with any deficiency in supply from Well I to be made up by appropriation from Well 2; that the PKIORITY OF THE RICHT dates from July 20, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The wells are to be LOCATED: Well I - 148 feet North and 880 feet East from the N1/4 Corner of Section 14, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 11 and Well 2 - 160 feet South and 872 feet East from the N1/4 Corner of Section 14, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 14, both being within Township I North, Range 12 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township I North Range 12 East, WM Section II SV/1/4 SE 1/4 2.5 acres Section I4 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 8.2 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 25, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
