### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10479 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Lawrence Morse of Chico Route, Box 38, Enterprise, Oregon 97828, for the use of the waters of two wells, being 1.52 cubic feet of water per second from Well 2 and 2.5 cfs from Well 3, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 3, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 4.02 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The wells are to be LOCATED: Well 2 - 1,200 feet South and 560 feet West from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 13, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 14, and Well 3 - 850 feet North and 70 feet West from the SE 1/4 Corner of Section 12, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 12, both being within Township 4 North, Range 29 East, W1M, in the County of Umatilla.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. Extended to Oct. 1, 1984

The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.
