PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10539 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to William D. or Joyce E. Kelly of 2901 Murphy Creek Road, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 862-2571, for the use of the waters of two wells, being 0.03 cubic foot per second of water from Well 1 and 0.07 cfs from Well 2, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 8, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.10 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or their equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The wells are to be LOCATED: Well 1 - 2,200 feet South and 730 feet East; Well 2 - 2,625 feet South and 570 feet East, both from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 2, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 2, Township 38 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The wells shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the wells at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain weirs, meters, or other suitable measuring devices, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 22, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
