PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62-10548 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Charles Drinkwater of PO Box 17, Lakeview, Oregon 97630, phone 947-4683 or 947-2352, for the use of the waters of a sump, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 14, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the sump, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The sump is to be LOCATED: 1,130 feet South and 1,030 feet West from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 13, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 13, Township 39 South, Range 19 East, WM, in the County of Lake.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 39 South Range 19 East, WM Section 13 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 10.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 22, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983. Extended to Oct. 1, 1984

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October I, 1984. Extended to Oct. 1985
