PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10613 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to City of Philomath of PO Box 549, Philomath, Oregon 97370, for the use of the waters of one well, for the PURPOSE of municipal water supply; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 15, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.22 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: North 80 degrees 23 minutes 42 seconds East, 1,786 feet from the Northwest Corner of DLC 46, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 12, Township 12 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Benton.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 12 South Range 5 West, WM Section 7 All Municipal Water Supply Range 6 West, WM Section 11 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 12 All

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 28, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
