## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10614 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to City of Philomath of PO Box 549, Philomath, Oregon 97370, for the use of the waters of two wells, being 250 gallons per minute from Well 1 and 500 gpm from Well 2, for the PURPOSE of municipal use; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 15, 1981 for 500.0 gpm and March 18, 1982 for 250.0 gpm, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 750 gpm measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or their equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

The wells are to be LOCATED: Well 1 - South 22 degrees 45 minutes East, 2,690 feet; Well 2 - South 21 degrees 52 minutes East, 2,830 feet, both from the Northwest Corner of DLC 46, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 11, Township 12 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Benton.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The wells shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the wells at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain weirs, meters, or other suitable measuring devices, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 28, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
