## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10627 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Alfred Meisner, Cascadian Nurseries of 13495 NW Thompson Road, Portland, Oregon 97229, phone 645-3351, for the use of the waters of a well, for the PURPOSE of irrigation, supplemental irrigation, and related nursery uses; being 0.08 cubic foot per second of water for irrigation, 0.08 cfs for supplemental irrigation, and 0.45 cfs for related nursery uses provided that the total diverted will not exceed 0.45 cfs. The use allowed herein for supplemental irrigation may be made any time between October 1 and March 31 that water can be put to beneficial use by irrigation, either for immediate crop growth, or for forecast requirements, to raise the soil moisture to field capacity in the soil profile to be utilized by plant growth in the subsequent growing season; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 18, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.45 measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: North 30 degrees 05 seconds West, 361.25 feet from the S1/4 Corner of Section 21, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 21, Township 1 North, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township I North Range I West, WM Section 21 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 6.57 acres nursery stock for in and out-of-season irrigation and related nursery uses

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be further limited not to exceed 1.0 acre-foot per acre irrigated during the period from October 1 to March 31, provided further that the right allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same land, shall not exceed 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated in any one year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 28, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
