## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-7925 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Charles Kozell of Route 1, Box 56, Dayton, Oregon 97114, phone 868-7398, for the use of the waters of two wells, being 15.0 gallons per minute from Well 1, and 55.0 gpm from Well 2, for the PURPOSE of irrigation, commercial use in container nursery and greenhouses, being 15.0 gpm from Well 1 and 55.0 gpm from Well 2 for commercial greenhouse and container nursery operation and 55.0 gpm from Well 2 for irrigation provided that the total diverted from Well 2 does not exceed 55.0 gpm; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 21, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 70.0 gpm measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or their equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The wells are to be LOCATED: Well 1 - 250 feet South and 2,150 feet west; Well 2 - 350 feet South and 2,150 feet West, both from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 9, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 9, Township 5 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill ~~ASTO~~

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that in the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation or repair of Well 1, the quantity of water allowed herein together with any other right from this point of appropriation shall not exceed the capacity of Well 1 at the time of perfection of this right, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The wells shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the wells at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain weirs, meters, or other suitable measuring devices, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

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Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 2, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
