PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10671 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Vergil D. Steinmetz, W.L. Dickson, James L. Opray, and Verne E. Mobley of PO Box 24A, Antelope, Gregon 97001, phone 489-3339, for the use of the waters of two wells, being 30.0 gallons per minute from Well 1 and 7.0 gpm from Well 2, for the PURPOSE of quasi-municipal use in the community of Antelope; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 17, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 37.0 gpm measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or their equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The wells are to be LOCATED: Well 1 - 1,380 feet North and 1,398 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 30, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 30, well 2 - 124 feet North and 958 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 30, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 30, both being within Township 7 South, Range 17 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 7 South Range 17 East, WM Section 32 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Quasi-municipal use SW 1/4 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Township 8 South Range 17 East, WM Section 5 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 NW 1/4

The wells shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the wells at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain weirs, meters, or other suitable measuring devices, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 2, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
