## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10446 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Keizer Water District by James W. Nightengale, Manager, of 641 Chemawa Road, NE, Salem, Oregon 97303, phone 393-1608, for the use of the waters of nine wells, for Quasi-municipal PURPOSES; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 13, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 28.12 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The wells are to be LOCATED: Delta Well - 1,680 feet North and 2,570 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 26, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 26, Township 6 South, Range 3 West, WM; McNary Well - 1,700 feet North and 960 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 34, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 34, Township 6 South, Range 3 West, WM; Weissner Well - 2,500 feet South and 960 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 1, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 1, Township 7 South, Range 3 West, WM; Chemawa Well - 470 feet South and 1,400 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 2, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 2, Township 7 South, Range 3 West, WM; Carlhaven West Well - 2,700 feet South and 2,800 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 2, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 2, Township 7 South, Range 3 West, WM; Carlhaven East Well - 2,700 feet South and 2,150 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 2, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 2, Township 7 South, Range 3 West, WM; Toni Well - 500 feet North and 130 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 2, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 2, Township 7 South, Range 3 West, WM; Burnside Well - 1,040 feet North and 1,770 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 3, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 3, Township 7 South, Range 3 West, WM; Willamette Manor Well - 760 feet South and 270 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 10, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 10, Township 7 South, Range 3 West, WM; Cherry Avenue Well - 50 feet South and 1,560 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 11, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 11, Township 7 South, Range 3 West, WM; Potts Well - 2,700 feet South and 1,580 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 11, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 11, Township 7 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Marion.

The wells shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the wells at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 20, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
