PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10556 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Kenneth D and Betty E. Prock of Route 2, Box 63, Millon-Freewater, Oregon 97862, phone 938-5768, for the use of the waters of Well 1 and Well 2, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation, being 0.24 cubic foot per second of water from Well 1, and 0.24 cfs from Well 2; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 17, 1981 for 0.42 cfs and June 21, 1982 for 0.06 cfs, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.48 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or their equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The wells are to be LOCATED: <u>Well I</u> - 710 feet South and 730 feet East; <u>Well 2</u> - 710 feet South and 960 feet East, both from the Northwest Corner of NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 35, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 32, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, WM, in the County of Unatilla.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenent, is as follows:

Township 6 North Range 35 East, WAI Section 32 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 38.5 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The wells shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the wells at all times.

The permitter shall install and maintain weirs, meters, or other suitable measuring devices, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 16, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
