PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10681 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Dave H. Brooks of Route 1, Box 906, Bandon, Oregon 97411, phone 347-9296, for the use of the waters of a sump, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation and temperature control, being 0.14 cubic foot of water per second for irrigation 0.82 cfs for temperature control, that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 15, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.82 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The sump well is to be LOCATED: 906 feet North and 2,274 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 18, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 18, Township 29 South, Range 14 West, WM, in the County of Coes.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 29 South Range 14 West, WM Section 18 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 5.5 acres irrigation and temperature control

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second of its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, for cranberries. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 9, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
