PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10765 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Robert E. Christiansen of Route 1, Box 905, Bandon, Oregon 97411, phone 347-2997, for the use of the waters of a sump, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation, temperature control; being 0.07 cubic foot per second of water for supplemental irrigation, 0.39 cfs for temperature control provided the total quantity diverted shall not exceed 0.39 cfs; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 1, 1982, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.39 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the sump, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The sump is to be LOCATED: 600 feet South and 2,300 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 18, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 18, Township 29 South, Range 14 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 29 South	Range 14 West, WM	Section 18	NW 1/4	NE 1/4	1.4 acres supplement- tal irrigation, and temperature control
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If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second of its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, for cranberries. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer, and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

The permittee shall record and submit annually to the Water Resources Department all pertinent data pertaining to use of water for temperature control (frost protection) on forms furnished.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 29, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
