PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10666 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Philip R. Stevenson of Route I, Box 13, Haines, Oregon 97833, phone 856-3659 for the use of the waters of two ponds

for the PURPOSE of irrigation and supplemental irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 8, 1982

0.77 cubic foot per and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed second

measured at the point of diversion from the ponds, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Pond 1-20 ft. North and 30 ft. West from the Southeast Corner of Section 1, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 1, Township 8 South, Range 38 East, WM; Pond 2-1,120 ft. South and 1,500 ft. East from the Northwest Corner of Section 7, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 7, Township 8 South, Range 39 East, WM; in the County of Baker. A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Pond I Township 8 South, Range 38 East, WM Section 1 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 5.0 acres primary SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 1 34.0 acres supplemental

Pond 2 Township 8 South, Range 39 East, WM Section 7 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 13.1 acres primary NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 7 8.9 acres supplemental

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 28, 1983 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 84.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 85 .
