## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10619 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to George Amstutz, Mayor for the City of Adrian, Oregon 97901, for use of the waters of Wells 1, 2, 3 and 4, being 0.22 cubic foot per second from Well 1, 0.12 cfs from each of Wells 2 and 3, and 0.45 cfs from Well 4 for the PURPOSE of municipal

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 31, 1981

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.91 cfs

measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well 1 - 75 feet North and 300 feet West from the Center of SE 1/4 of Section 15, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 15; Well 2 - 1,418 feet North and 659 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 14; Well 3 - 1,403 feet North and 609 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 14; Well 4 - 2,536 feet North and 712 feet East \* A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

\* from the Southwest Corner of Section 14, all within Township 21 South, Range 46 East, WM, in the County of Malheur.

Township 21 South, Range 46 East, WM Section 14 municipal use

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 23, 1983, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984. Extended to October 1, 1990

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985. Extended to October 1, 1990
