PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **G-10837** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Stayton Canning Co. Co-op (by Mark Steele, Engineer) of 4755 Brooklake Road, NE, Salem, Oregon 97305, phone 393-4221 (plant), 769-2101, for the use of the waters of Well 5

for the PURPOSE of cannery use

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 17, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **1.57** cubic feet per second

measured at the point of diversion from the well , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: **3,167** feet South 74 degrees 05 minutes East from the Re-entrant Corner on the West line of the Augustus Lambert DLC 61, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 8, Township 6 South, Range 2 West, WM, in the County of Marion.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 6 South, Range 2 West, WM	Section 8	SE 1/4	SW 1/4	plant
	Section 17	NE 1/4	NW 1/4	plant

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **January 5, 1984** , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 19 85** .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before **October 1, 19 86** .
