PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-9832 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Rainbow Water District of PO Box 8, Springfield, Oregon, phone 746-1676, for use of the waters of one well

for the PURPOSE of quasi-municipal use

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 14, 1980

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.56 cubic foot per second

measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 109.9 feet South and 552.4 feet East from the Southwest Corner of W. Spencer Donation Land Claim 50, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 26, Township 17 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Lane.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 11, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984. Extended to October 1, 1989

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985. Extended to October 1, 1989
