### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10851 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Mary C. Benson of 4278 Beagle Road, Central Point, Oregon 97502, phone 826-9328, for the use of the waters of three wells; being 18.0 gallons per minute from Well 1; 75.0 gpm from Well 2 and 75.0 gpm from Well 3 for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 6, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 168.0 gpm;

measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well 1 - 1,230 feet South and 1,300 feet West; Well 2 - 1,200 feet South and 1,800 feet West; Well 3 - 1,300 feet South and 2,410 feet West, all from the Northeast Corner of Section 12, being within: Well 1 - NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Well 2 - NW 1/4 NE 1/4; Well 3 - NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 35 South, Range 2 West, WM, in the County of Jackson. A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 35 South, Range 2 West, WM	Section 12	NW 1/4	NE 1/4	23.0 acres
	Section 1	SW 1/4	SE 1/4	7.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 11, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985. *Extended to Oct. 1, 1986*
