PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-9705 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Arthur W. Pullen of 4109 Chenowith Road, The Dalles, Oregon 97058, phone 296-5141, for use of the waters of 1 well

for the PURPOSE of domestic supplies for 30 families including irrigation of lawns and gardens not to exceed one-half acre in area per family

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 23, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.1 cubic foot per second

measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 1,145 feet North and 721.06 feet West from Southwest Corner of Justin Chenowith DLC 37, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 30, Township 2 North, Range 13 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 18, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
