## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **G-10349** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Avion Water Co., Inc., 60813 Parrell Road, Bend, Oregon 97702, phone 382-5342** for use of the waters of 2 wells, being 0.15 cubic foot per second from Well 1 and 0.42 from Well 2

for the PURPOSE of **group domestic use for 188 families including irrigation of lawns and gardens not to exceed one-half acre in area per family (Wildriver)**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **May 29, 1981**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.57 cfs**

measured at the point of diversion from the **wells**, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well 1 - 900 feet North and 1,258 feet East from the Center Quarter Corner of Section 23, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 23; Well 2 - 940 feet South and 490 feet East from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 23, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 23, both in Township 21 South, Range 9 East, WM, in the County of Deschutes.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Use of water under this permit shall be limited to the appropriation of water only to the extent that such appropriation does not interfere with or deplete the flow of the Deschutes River. Any depletion will require the wells to be shut down, since the Deschutes River has been closed to further appropriation.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **March 18, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 1984**. *Extended to October 1, 1989, extended to 10-1-94, 10-1-99*

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before **October 1, 1985**. *Extended to October 1, 1989, extended to 10-1-94, 10-1-99*
