### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10526 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to AG-DRYERS, Inc., Box 280, Vale, Oregon 97918, phone 473-2216, for use of the waters of 1 well

for the PURPOSE of agricultural commodity drying

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 8, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.39 cubic foot per second

measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 60.50 feet South and 60.50 feet West from Southeast Corner of NE 1/4 SW 1/4 SE 1/4, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 20, Township 18 South, Range 45 East, WM, in the County of Malheur.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 18 South, Range 45 East, WM Section 20 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Geothermal com  
dryer

The use of water for agricultural commodity drying in excess of 5,000 gallons per day shall be subsequent in priority to future beneficial consumptive use unless a two well system is constructed and all water wasted from the system is recharged to the same ground water reservoir from which it was withdrawn, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 18, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
